COPE's Executive Committee to meet Western Cape leadership for 2026 election preparation and party rebuilding plans

The Congress Executive Committee (CEC), which comprises the COPE's top five leadership, will hold a consultative meeting with the party's provincial leadership in the Western Cape on Saturday, 18 January 2025.

The consultative meeting continues the implementation process of the party's unrelenting determination to rebuild democratic structures throughout the country in preparation for a democratic elective National Congress in the first half of 2025.

Unlike other political parties who impose leaders on their members through "appointments," COPE is determined to preserve the sustainability of a democratic culture in which the membership's will is respected and sacrosanct. The party belongs to its members, who must determine its content and direction. Integrity is one of COPE's core values.

The purpose of the meeting is to inform the extended leadership collectives from municipal constituencies and the provincial leadership on the progress made in the national rebuilding process and to receive a report on the party's activities in the Western Cape.
